

- Visited the Batman Gallery often when he came to San Francisco and stayed with Robert La Vigne who lived 2 blocks away. He used to play and sing with his ocarina (concertina) to Hazel and Mike Agron. He drew a fish on the plaster wall of the Batman office in blue felt tipped pen (new at the time). When the Gallery closed in 1965, the "fish painting" was chiseled out of the wall and given to the Manager.
- Had been to India and other places in Asia and gave written advice to M. Agron about the "Tibetan Tankas" he had acquired following Tibetan exodus in 1950's.
- Had a great capacity to reach out to the good soul of people; would react to things that confronted him by playing and singing.
- Attended poetry readings conducted by Batman at Fillmore Street, Monterey and Big Sur.
